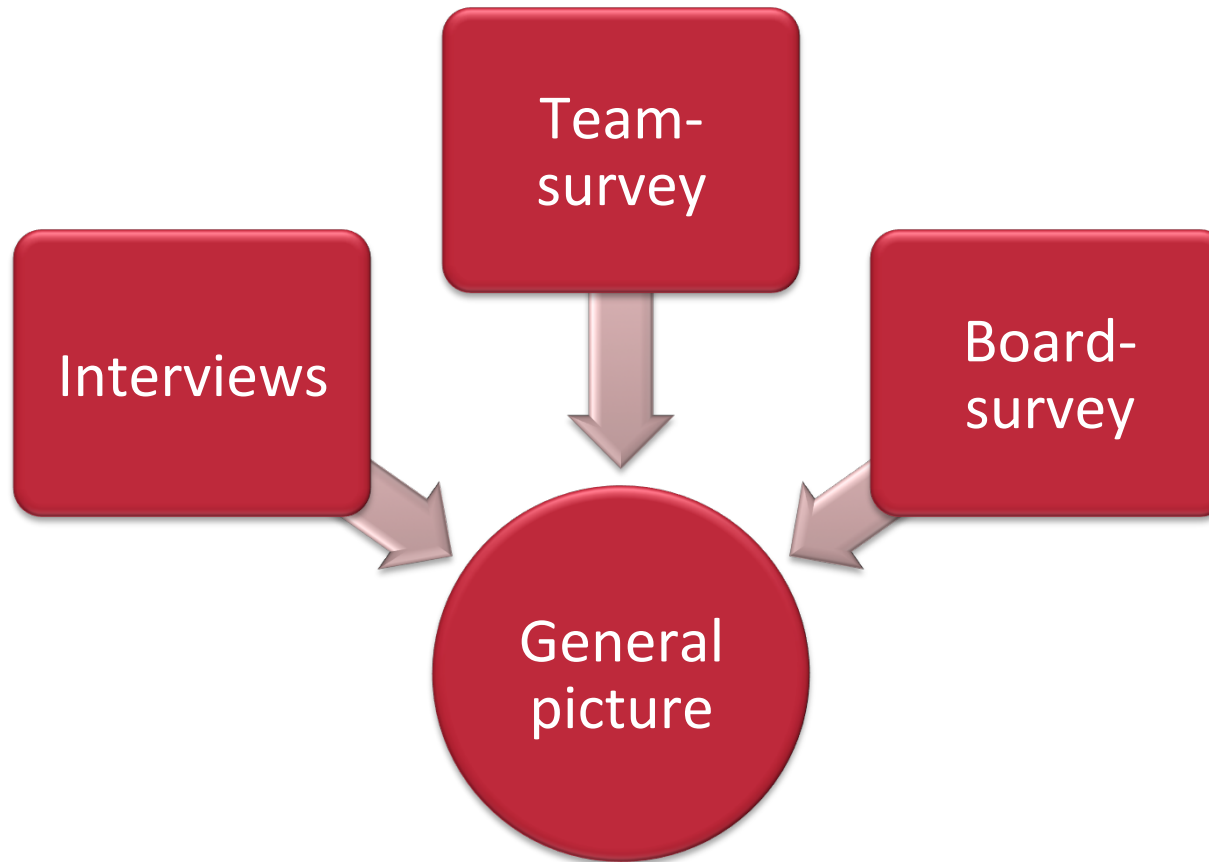
## A Board Assessment ensures the quality of the board's work and competence for the mission
